President Allison Snyder called the meeting to order at 4:05 pm.

- Approval of minutes: September 20th, 2021: Pat moved the approval of the September minutes, Allison seconded. The minutes were approved.
- 2. Treasurer's Report: September 2021: Deb moved to approve the September report, Maria seconded. The report was approved. Les reported that everything looks good, especially with tax money coming in soon. He mentioned that he had looked into investing some funds into a high interest account, but felt as though we don't have enough extra money to do so presently. Instead, he recommended that we hold off on investing and keep some savings on hand for emergency use.
- Director's Report: September 2021: Melanie reported some of the major projects happening:
 - Perspectives from the Pandemic- This will be concluding during the October art walk with an art show and conversation about the work.
 - Communities for Immunity Grant- Melanie is reaching out to local doctors and the St. Bonaventure physician assistant program to find speakers.
 - Melanie will be presenting on Nov. 5th at NYLA. (New York Library Association)
 - Melanie is working to start a conversation about restorative agriculture and sustainability using the Kiss the Ground documentary.
 - Updating website and consolidating documents, updating the strategic plan and working on a new strategic plan

- Although nobody participated in the last two focus groups targeting homeschoolers and teens, Melanie was able to talk to some homeschooling families/teens on separate occasions to gather more data.
- 4. Old Business: The 1 Hour Yearly Training does not begin until 2022, so board members will not need to start training until the new year. All board members do need to participate in annual sexual harassment training. Melanie will offer training in December.
- New Business: The board went into Executive Session at 4:24 pm to review payroll.
