The year 2023 started off like most years do here in Alfred: with gray skies, snow flurries, and regular library happenings. Things were running smoothly until April when a plumbing issue caused the building to be contaminated with sewage and the task at hand seemed daunting. For work to be completed, the entire library collection would need to be boxed up and stored. For reference, the library has just under 13,000 items in its physical collection.

Construction and re-settling wrapped up just in time for summer reading to begin, one of the busiest times of the year at the library. We had the biggest summer reading program since before the pandemic!

Despite all of that, the library continued to grow and serve the community. Our collection grew by 1,099 items, largely in part through a grant project with the Children's Book Council! We offered 119 programs attended by 927 people. Storytime programs grew by 21%.
