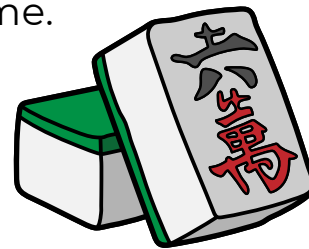
### True Crime Book Club

Meets the first Tuesday of every month at 5:00pm at Terra Cotta Coffeehouse.



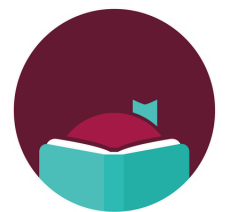
### Mah Jongg at the Library
