Tech News

The library was selected as one of 30 libraries nationwide to participate in the American Library Association's Community Connect: Fostering Digital Access Grant. Not only does this grant continue our hotspot lending program, but it now includes 5 laptop computers that are available for check out.

Over 7% of American households have no internet access. That's over 9 million households! This grant aims to provide access to healthcare, job opportunities, education, and social connection through technology.

Our laptops will be available for check out in early August. Please check our social media or website for updates. Laptops will be checked out for 1 week with 1 renewal. Patrons must be 18+ years old and have a library card at an STLS member library in good standing.
