April 2023 Director's Report

Meetings Attended:

- 4/4-Claims returned meeting- how to document in WF when a patron says they've returned something, but we do not have it
- 4/5- participated in the EDISJ (Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Social Justice) panel discussion
- 4/17- phone meeting with Pat B. STLS to set up WF on laptop
- 4/11, 13, 28- Meetings with Jamie Babcock to discuss repairs to building and project planning

Activities/ FYI:

- We were notified we'd been selected to participate in Free Comic Book Day (5/6), and would receive free comic books to distribute.
- We received a letter from Alfred Oaks Solar Project that they had filed an application to begin the project. This project is a PILOT (Payment in Lieu of Taxes) in which the Town and Village of Alfred, and Alfred-Almond Central School would receive payments for a determined number of years. Libraries are eligible to receive PILOTs too. Brian Hildreth advised that I reach out to Craig Clark with the Allegany County IDA to find out if we could be a part of this project, and if not, if he could let us know of any future projects.
- Library Director and trustees participated in Hot Dog Day!
- Annual report newsletter was received from Alfred State Print Mail services. Newsletters were delivered to the post offices on Friday, April 28.
- Brian Hildreth suggested we start a donation page that community members might donate to, as we are uncertain of how much insurance will cover, our insurance deductible and other costs associated with the sewage leak. I reached out to Tina Dalton, director of the Cuba Circulating Library, who underwent a similar process last year when their basement flooded. She used Facebook fundraiser tools rather than GoFundMe. When comparing the two, Facebook took a smaller percentage of donations. They also pay directly to PayPal. So I was able to set up a PayPal account for the library, and receive charity status, so that decreases the percentage from Facebook from 6% to 1.8%.
 - To date we have received \$3,105 from Facebook donations (57 donors) and \$1,870 in checks.



Tuesday, May 16, 2023 4:00 PM

In Attendance: Allison Snyder, President; Deb Stephens, Vice-President; Megan Parry, Secretary; Sam Frechette, Kim MacCrae, Carlyn Yanda. On Zoom: Mechele Romanchock Excused Absence: Pat Crandall, Treasurer; Amy Powers.

Also present: Melanie Miller, Library Director.

- 1. Approval of Minutes, April 11, 2023: Allison Snyder moved to approve, Debbie Stephens seconded, and the Minutes were approved.
- 2. Treasurer's Report: Tabled until Pat Crandall can meet with Allison and Melanie Miller to go over the many unusual expenditures resulting from the recent Sewer Event.
- 3. Director's Report: The Library received a slew of grants. (A):Jackie Wilson fetched \$1000 from the Foundation for Southern Tier Libraries to fund a Fiber Arts Lending Library. (B): Melanie received \$1500 from Dollar General for the Summer Reading Program. (C): The Library's Summer Concert Series, funded by a large grant from the Arts Council for Wyoming County, will take place outdoors from 5 to 7pm on Mondays, with one from 6 to 8pm. The Terra Cotta will cater (set up a food tent.) (D): Melanie has applied for more funding, also from the ACWC, to present a Fiber Workshop with a visiting artist.
- 4. Sewer Event: Emergency fundraising on FaceBook brought in \$3205, and contributions from the community added another \$2440. Some of this money will replace two dedicated

shelving units (\$1100) and a changing table for the bathroom (\$150.) When additional purchases approach or total the above contributions, the Alfred Sun will publish a Thank You Letter from Melanie and the Board, along with an accounting of the expenditures. The Library is very grateful for the financial help it has received.

- 5. The Board discussed some future fundraising ideas, perhaps to be implemented in December.
- 6. Allison adjourned the meeting at 4:34pm, and Board members traipsed over to the Library to admire the new carpet and paint job.
- 7. Next meeting: June 13, at 4pm in the SDB Parish House
